



Regional Coalition Development

At this time, we are seeking out individuals and organizations to assist the IPC in creating increased awareness for person centered long term care throughout Illinois. We are doing this through stronger development of Regional Coalitions.

The primary role of a Regional Coalitions is to bring education and training to the communities around the state. Through IPC assistance, each Regional Coalition will bring educational opportunities to their local community. These Regional Coalitions will then connect with each other through the Illinois Pioneer Coalition's Regional Coordinator so that best practices and resources can be shared.

Responsibilities of the Regional Coalition Coordinator:

- Assist the IPC with Backyard education offerings - The IPC would solicit the speaker based upon the Regional Coalitions stated needs. The Regional Coalition would then assist the IPC Education Coordinator by helping to find a site for the training, secure any refreshments, advertise the event and assist the IPC on the day of the event.
- Conduct planning meeting with a core group of individuals in each region. This group will be your Leadership Committee who will assist with all tasks associated with the Regional development and education, both Backyard trainings and other Regional initiated events.
- Funds are available to assist with providing regionals training sessions. This is a method to bring speakers into each region that can speak to important topics that your members desire. To obtain these funds a Project Funding Proposal needs to be completed (form provided). Up to \$250 can be requested for each event.
